To be eligible for admission, candidates must meet the following criteria:

1. > Hold a degree in law obtained from a foreign institution that is recognized as equivalent to a French Master 1.
2. > Hold one of the following French language diplomas (level B2 minimum) :
 - > Test de connaissance du français (TCF), with the written expression part
 - > Test d'évaluation de français (TEF)
 - > Diplôme d'études en langue française (DELF)
 - > DU de FLE (Français Langue Étrangère) from French universities
 - > Diplôme du Cours de civilisation française de la Sorbonne

The degree program consists of the following components:

Core Courses:

- > Introduction to Public Law
- > Introduction to Private Law
- > Study Direction and Methodology
- > French Language

In addition, there are two mandatory courses:

- > Civil Law : contracts - First Semester (lectures and tutorials)
- > Civil Law : legal responsibilities and other sources - Second Semester (lectures and tutorials)

Students are also required to choose one of the following elective courses:

- > General Law of obligations (lectures and tutorials)
- > Special Contracts Law (lectures and tutorials)
- > Family Law (lectures and tutorials)
- > Civil procedure (lectures and tutorials)
- > Private International Law (lectures and tutorials)
